

The teachers interviewed all agreed on how the Seniors have handled the pandemic, becoming well-adapted and strong young men and women. The students have become flexible and able to adapt to the situation.

Journalism and English teacher Mrs. O'Lare remarked, "I think they have handled [the pandemic] very well, [they have become] very flexible, and they came out of the pandemic and put effort into their work again. It was a hard transition [for the Seniors] to make."

Biology teacher Mr. Smith said, "I think [the Seniors} have adapted better than anyone could have expected. You guys weathered the storm much better than middle school kids at the time. Much more mature."

Spanish teacher Mrs. Banish noted, "I think that they have handled [COVID-19] as well as can be expected. They were the first class to really experience COVID from the beginning. They were the COVID class and I think they have done a really good job [overcoming the challenges that it brought.]"

Sports Medicine teacher Mr. Porterfield noted, "[They handled COVID] like Champs. Of any class, they have rolled with the punches more than any other group. There was a ton of uncertainty, and the other grades got away with much more."
