The nature of many classes at THS has allowed teachers to have students for multiple years. Foreign language teachers and some AP teachers are able to develop close relationships with their students this way.

History teacher Mr. Polansky, a top-rated teacher with this year's seniors, stated, "Anybody who took Honors World and/or AP Euro I have felt the closest to. Also, the people who come to see me. Rarely does a Senior walk in who I am not happy to see."

Smith responded, "All of my AP Bio Students [have impacted me]. I was very happy to have them come back, and I felt cheated from [the shorter] freshmen year. I had 35 people come back for AP Bio.

McLaughlin noted, "I think the most positive thing is my German V students. I've spent three years with them and we've developed inside jokes. They have taught me as much as I've taught them."

Phillips stated, "They are the most talented, accomplished group of young people I have taught, [and my favorite memory is] every day in Calc BC."

Porterfield commented, "My sports medicine kids, specifically Carys Miller, Harley Griffith, Jayla Sebititich, Ty Banco, and Rihanna Shrum. I have gotten to know those kids very well and have seen them grow."
