Smith noted, "I hope that when they get to college and take a bio course, they will be well prepared and think I did a good job preparing them for college. Hopefully, they will consider me a kind person who doesn't give pop quizzes."

Polansky remarked, "I'll never get Teacher of the Year, but they know I care for and will continue to care for them until I die."

Porterfield said, "[I want to be remembered] as somebody that they learned something from and someone who cared deeply about them."

Banish said, "[I want to be remembered] as a fair teacher, a teacher who helps and teaches them, maybe as a fun teacher."

Phillips sarcastically remarked, "I hope they don't [remember me]."
